1. Rights of Public Entity

Otjozondjupa Regional Council reserves the right:

- (a) To split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per item, and
- (b) To accept or reject any quotation or to cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.
- c) To return all the products that does not meet the standard and such products to be replaced at the cost of the supplier.
- (d) to cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the goods mentioned in Section III, by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) the Quotation Letter in Section II with its annex for Bid Securing Declaration
- (b) the Priced Activity Schedule in Section IV;
- (c) the Specifications and Performance Standards in Section V; and
- (d) any other attachment as deemed appropriate.

3. Validity of Quotations

The quotation validity period shall be for **30 days** from the date of submission deadline.

4. Eligibility Criteria

Bids by post should reach Otjozondjupa Regional Council; by the same date and time at latest. Late bids will be rejected and returned to the bidder unopened. Bids received by e-mail or fax will not be considered.

9. Opening of Quotations

Bids will be opened internally by the OTRC immediately after the closing time referred to in section 9 above. Bidders or their representatives may attend the Bid Opening if they choose to do so.

10. Evaluation of Quotations

Otjozondjupa Regional Council shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of evaluated cost to determine the lowest evaluated quotation.

The threshold amount of the goods will be determined by the Employer 5% under or above the threshold amount will be the most responsive amount during evaluation.
